## ***What is Sthaayi.in?***

Sthaayi is a platform dedicated to making Sanskrit accessible, relatable, and a part of everyday life. We bring the language into the modern world through creative media—Sanskrit vlogs, podcasts, music videos, and short films—that connect with today’s generation. Whether it’s food vlogs, travel diaries, or fitness content, we present them in simple, conversational Sanskrit, making learning both natural and fun.

In today’s fast-paced world, most people—be it corporate professionals, college students, business owners, or freelancers—get a moment for themselves only on a Sunday morning. What started with just eight friends from Sthaayi.in casually practicing Sanskrit on a walk has now grown into the Sanskrit Walk at Cubbon Park, attracting 60 to 70 participants every weekend. With an 80% retention rate since the first session, this community has proven that Sanskrit is not just for scholars—it’s for everyone. We learn through experience—chatting in Sanskrit while walking, playing games like Dumb Charades and Antakshari using Sanskrit subhashitas, and even working out while counting in Sanskrit. We’ve even introduced Gen Z lingo in Sanskrit—like Kimbho for “What’s up?” and Prajwalitam for “Lit.” These weekends, now known as KIMBHO Sanskrit Weekends, always end with a sun-kissed Suryachumbitam picture.

Beyond the walks, Sthaayi.in brings Sanskrit to the roads and beyond with Sanskrit Motorbike Rides, Sanskrit Tours, and Sanskrit Jamming Sessions, all of which happen every month.

And the impact doesn’t stop there. Through our online Sanskrit sessions, thousands of students across the world learn and engage with the language every year, making Sanskrit a living, breathing part of their daily lives.

As the founder of Sthaayi.in, I can say that after every session, every gathering, and every journey, Sanskrit has revived us. It has made us better human beings, more mindful, and more connected. We don’t claim to be reviving Sanskrit—this language has no beginning and no end. It is eternal, and it will persist till the kingdom comes, no matter what.

Samashti believes Sanskrit isn't just a language of the past—it's meant to be lived, spoken, and experienced today. As the founder of *Sthaayi.in*, she's making Sanskrit more accessible and engaging through vlogs, podcasts, jamming sessions, motorbike rides, and community-driven events. - Sanskrit Road Signs & Code Words – Use Sanskrit for hand signals, turns, and formations - ride like a true Sanskrit Rider!

## **Batch 1 of The Sanskrit Ride -Leh Ladakh 2025**

Date : 12th September 2025 - 22nd September 2025

### Day 1 : 12th september

- Our journey starts from **Delhi** to **Manali** in a pre booked bus. Cabs will be booked from Delhi Airport to the bus stand (this expense is exclusive of package)
- This journey from Delhi to Manali will be over night.

### Day 2 : 13th September

#### **Arrival in Manali | Settle In & Explore**

- Arrive in **Manali** and check into your pre-booked hotel.
- Enjoy a hearty breakfast with scenic valley views.
- The rest of the day is at leisure—explore local markets, cafés, or nearby attractions on your own and at your own expense.
- In the evening, attend a briefing session to get important ride details.
- Collect your bikes and be ready for the next morning.
- End the day with a delicious dinner and an overnight stay at the hotel.

### Day 3: 14th September

#### **Manali to Jispa | The Ride Begins**

- Morning bike check-up to ensure everything is road-ready.
- Official flag-off—engines roar as we begin the epic ride!
- Ride through the stunning **Solang Valley**, a perfect warm-up for the journey ahead.
- Cross the **Atal Tunnel**, one of the longest high-altitude tunnels in the world.
- Stop at the **Sissu Waterfall**, a breathtaking sight in the **Lahaul Valley**.
- Pass through **Keylong**, the last major town before reaching the remote Himalayan terrain.
- Reach **Jispa**, a picturesque riverside village—perfect for unwinding after the ride.
- Dinner & overnight stay in prebooked hotel at Jispa, surrounded by the serene beauty of the mountains.

## Day 4: 15th September

### **Jispa to Leh | The Ultimate Himalayan Ride**

- Early morning departure from **Jispa**—today's ride is long but legendary!
- Cross **Darcha**, the last settlement before entering high-altitude terrain.
- Stop at **Deepak Tal** and **Suraj Tal**, two pristine alpine lakes reflecting the sky.
- Conquer **Baralacha La** (16,040 ft), where three valleys meet in a breathtaking panorama.
- Tackle the famous **Gata Loops**—21 thrilling hairpin bends that test both skill and endurance.
- Pass through **Nakee La** (15,547 ft), **Lachung La** (16,616 ft), and **Tanglang La** (17,582 ft)—each offering surreal landscapes and a sense of achievement.
- Dinner and overnight stay.

## Day 5: 16th September

### **Leh to Nubra | The Desert in the Mountains**

- Early morning ride towards **Khardung La** (17,982 ft), one of the highest motorable passes in the world.
- Stop at the Khardung La top for photos and to soak in the breathtaking Himalayan views.
- Descend into the stunning **Nubra Valley**, known for its unique cold desert landscape.
- Visit the Diskit Monastery, home to the towering **Maitreya Buddha Statue** overlooking the valley.
- Experience a **Bactrian camel ride** on the Hunder Sand Dunes, where the desert meets the snow-capped mountains.
- Dinner & overnight stay in Nubra, under a sky full of stars.

## Day 6: 17th September

### **Nubra to Pangong | The Ever-Changing Terrain**

- Morning ride through the scenic **Shyok Valley**, where mountains and rivers create a breathtaking route.
- Pass through **Agham** and **Shyok**, enjoying the raw beauty of Ladakh's rugged landscapes.
- Stop at **Durbuk** and **Tangtse**, small yet charming villages offering a glimpse of local life.
- Arrive at the stunning **Pangong Lake**, where the crystal-clear waters change shades of blue with the sunlight.
- Spend the evening by the lake, soaking in the surreal scenery and Ladakh's peaceful vibes.
- Dinner & overnight stay in camps near Pangong, under a sky bursting with stars.

## Day 7: 18th September

### **Pangong to Hanle | Riding Through the Untouched**

- Begin the ride from **Pangong Lake**, heading into Ladakh's lesser-explored regions.
- Pass through **Chushul**, a historic village near the Indo-China border.
- Ride past the stunning high-altitude lakes—**Mirpal Tso and Yaya Tso**, known for their pristine beauty.
- Conquer **Kaksang La and Thato La**, testing both skill and endurance.
- Reach **Hanle**, home to India's **highest observatory**, offering one of the clearest night skies in the world.
- **Dinner & overnight stay** in Hanle, stargazing like never before.

## Day 8: 19th September

### **Hanle to Umling La to Leh | Reaching the Highest**

- Ride to **Umling La (19,024 ft)**—the **highest motorable road in the world!**
- Pass through **Nurpu La Top** and cross the famous **Chisumle Bridge** on the way.
- Take in the breathtaking Himalayan views from **Umling La Top**, a bucket-list achievement for every rider.
- Descend back to **Leh**, reflecting on the unreal experience of riding at the top of the world.
- **Dinner & overnight stay** in Leh.

## Day 9: 20th September

### **Leh to Kargil | A Ride Through History**

- Visit **Shanti Stupa**, a symbol of peace with panoramic views of Leh.
- Pay homage at the **Hall of Fame**, honoring the bravery of soldiers in Ladakh.
- Stop at **Gurudwara Pathar Sahib**, known for its spiritual significance.
- Experience the mystery of **Magnetic Hill**, where vehicles seem to defy gravity.
- Witness the **Sangam** of the **Indus and Zaskar Rivers**, a sight to behold.
- Ride past **Lamayuru**, one of Ladakh's oldest monasteries, and conquer **Fotu La & Namika La**.
- Reach **Kargil** for a **dinner & overnight stay**, soaking in the historic significance of this town.

## Day 10: 21st September

### **Kargil to Srinagar | A Tribute & A Ride**

- Visit the **Kargil War Memorial in Drass**, honoring the heroes of 1999.
- Ride through **Zero Point**, a snow-laden paradise near Drass.
- Conquer the dramatic **Zoji La Pass**, a thrilling and scenic ride into Kashmir.
- Reach **Srinagar**, where the beauty of Dal Lake welcomes us.
- **Dinner & overnight stay** in Srinagar.

Day 11: 22nd September

### **Srinagar Departure | The Journey Ends**

- Enjoy a final **breakfast in Srinagar**, soaking in the last moments of this incredible ride.
- Bid farewell to the mountains, carrying home **unforgettable memories and friendships**.
- Tour ends, but the adventure stays with you forever.
